**AIR QUALITY MANAGEMENT ORDER NO. 1.
ENVIRONMENT ACT 1995 SECTION 83**


(A14 Corridor Bar Hill to Milton: Nitrogen Dioxide)

South Cambridgeshire District Council, South Cambridgeshire Hall, Cambourne Business Park, Cambourne, Cambridge, CB3 6EA (the council) in exercise of the powers conferred on it by the Environment Act 1995 section 83 makes the following order:-

1. This order may be cited as the South Cambridgeshire District Council Air Quality Management Area Order No. 1 (A14 Corridor Bar Hill to Milton: Nitrogen Dioxide) and will come into operation on 1st August 2007.
2. The area that is (shaded red) on the plan prepared and sealed with the common seal of the Council is declared to be the Air Quality Management Area (the designated area). The map is deposited at the offices of the Council.
3. This Order may be varied or revoked by a subsequent Order.
4. When this Order comes into operation, the Council will cause a further assessment to be made of the air quality at present and the likely future air quality within the designated area, in respect of the likelihood that the air quality objective for nitrogen dioxide (annual mean) will be exceeded within the designated area and will report the findings within 12 months.
5. Within 18 months of this Order coming into operation the Council will prepare a written action plan setting out its intention to pursue the achievement of air quality standards and objectives in the designated area.
6. The Council may revise the area and/or the action plan from time to time.
